What is an energy ETF?

An energy ETF focuses specifically on companies in the energy sector, typically including oil, natural gas, and renewable energy firms. These sector ETFs work by offering exposure to energy-focused indexes, which are predefined lists of companies selected and weighted according to a set of rules.

How are solar energy ETFs ranked?

Solar Energy and all other industries are ranked based on their aggregate assets under management (AUM) for all the U.S.-listed ETFs that are classified by ETF Database as being mostly exposed to those respective industries. If an ETF's industry classification changes, it will affect the aggregate AUM calculations.
