Does Puerto Rico have a power plant?

One of the main power plants supplying power to Puerto Rico is the Palo Seco fuel oil power plant located near Palo Seco, Toa Baja. Before Hurricane Irma and Hurricane Maria struck Puerto Rico in September 2017, the Palo Seco plant was slated to close.

Will Puerto Rico have a hydrogen power plant?

The start-up date of the new plant is expected to be June 30, 2028. Energiza is made up of the Puerto Rican companies Tropigas de Puerto Rico Inc. and Cratos Project Services PR LLC, and also has Mitsubishi Americas Power Inc. and NAES Corp. as part of its team.
