Why did Lisbon go offline?

Lisbon goes offline and people hit the cafes. Lisbon experienced a severe blackout yesterday as power went down across Portugal, Spain, and parts of France. The cause of the blackout is still unknown, but two "disconnection events" in south-west Spain are being suggested as the possible origin.

How many power plants are in Portugal?
