How to reset a circuit breaker safely?

Follow these detailed steps to reset a circuit breaker safely: Turn Off Appliances: Before resetting the circuit breaker, it's crucial to turn off all appliances and devices connected to the affected circuit. How long does it take a breaker to reset?

Reset the Breaker: Firmly push the tripped breaker to the "off" position and flip it back to "on."
