## Sales price of solar panels in Uzbekistan

What is a large-scale solar PV project in Uzbekistan?

Large-scale solar PV projects have been subject to competitive bidding processes in Uzbekistan since 2019 and an awarded project can sign a long-term contract with NEGU at a fixed tariff, as noted above. The government of Uzbekistan also aims to develop small- and medium-scale solar projects.

Who collects energy statistics in Uzbekistan?

The State Committee of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Statistics is the official authority collecting energy statistics. It will play an important role in the future in collecting data on off-grid solar photovoltaics and solar heat use in households.

Will Uzbekistan increase solar PV capacity by 2030?

Solar PV capacity in Uzbekistan is still negligible, but the government aims to rapidly increase its capacity up to 5 GW by 2030.

What is the energy potential of Uzbekistan?

Uzbekistan has considerable renewable energy potential, a substantial amount of which lies in solar energy. The solar energy gross potential totals 2 134 x 10<sup>3</sup> PJ, while technical potential is estimated at 7 411 PJ, which is equivalent to almost four times the country's current primary energy consumption (Table 1).
