Can I use a 20V battery in a 60V DeWalt tool?

No, 20V batteries are exclusive to 20V DeWalt tools. The 60V tools have different voltage requirements and cannot use a 20V battery. One battery pack can run several tools, but they must match in voltage.

How many volts is a dcb606 Flexvolt battery?

Find the instruction manual. *Maximum initial battery voltage (measured without a workload) is 20, 60, and 120 volts. Nominal voltage is 18, 54, and 108. 120V MAX is based on using 2 DEWALT 60V MAX* lithium-ion batteries combined. **With DCB606 FLEXVOLT™ battery when used with DEWALT 20V MAX* tools compared to DCB201 1.5 Ah battery pack.
